



Ramada Plaza Wrexham Opens its Doors for Business

The Ramada Plaza Wrexham, Wrexham's premier 4 star hotel has opened its doors for business. The hotel features 85 deluxe air-conditioned en-suite bedrooms and substantial conference & banqueting facilities. The £7.6m hotel was developed by David McLean Developments in a 12-month build period. The hotel project was supported by Wrexham County Borough Council and the Wales Tourist Board.
